The Jain Community of Chennai, with a strong sense of social responsibility and a passion for service, established Shree Chandraprabhu Jain College in Minjur in 1997, the Golden Jubilee year of India's Independence.

The College, established by Shree Chandraprabhu Jain Educational Foundation is affiliated with the University of Madras. The College is Managed by the Jain Minority Institution within the meaning of Articles 29 and 30 of the Constitution of India.

The College commenced its functioning from Vijayadasami Day 11.10.1997 and is now offering 09 U.G Courses and 2 P.G. Courses from 2002-03 onwards, it has also been recognized as Co-Educational Institution.

The Management strongly believes that right knowledge is a basic requirement for the pursuit of spiritual aims, Righteous conduct, integration of creed, word and deed and the ultimate emancipation of the soul from the mundane world are also the essential goals for all human beings. Besides, we also believe that learning should be a pleasant experience.

The College is situated in an ideal location, far away from the buzzle and din of the city, yet well within the bounds of Chennai Metro, less than half a kilometer from Minjur Railway Station. The sprawling campus has playgrounds, green lawns and saplings of several species with bushes and shrubs, sporting their blooms of various colours, and with the architecture are the landmark of magnificence.

The Building complex has a total built-up area of over One lakh Sq.ft. with all facilities. The Library has a total Collection of over 13,500 books apart from magazines and journals covering all subjects. The State of the Art Computer Laboratory is fully Air-conditioned. The college has a standby generator of 125 KVA & another 63.5 KVA Capacity to ensure uninterrupted power supply.

There are excellent facilities for academic work as well as for Gymnastics/Games/Sports along with many extra – curricular and co-curricular activities. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Candidates seeking admission to the under graduate degree courses should have passed the Higher Secondary Course (Plus Two) Examination conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu or any other equivalent examination recognized by the University of Madras. In addition to this:

1. Applicants to B.Sc. (Computer Science) should have studied Mathematics and Computer Science as subjects in HSC.
2. Applicants to B.C.A. (Computer Applications) should have studied Mathematics, Computer Science as subject in HSC in addition, 30% of seats are reserved for students who have studied Commerce with Computer Application as a subject in HSC.
3. Applicants to B.Sc. (Electronics with Artificial Intelligence) should have studied Physics with Mathematics, Computer Science or Biology or Pure Science as subjects in HSC.
4. Applicants to B.Sc. (Plant Biology & Bio- Technology) should have studied Pure Science, Biology, and Chemistry as subjects in HSC.
5. Applicants to B.Sc. (Chemistry) should have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, Biology or Pure Science in HSC or equivalent.
6. Applicants to M.Sc., should have studied B.Sc. (Comp. Science), B.C.A. or any Degree course with Mathematics or Statistics as a subject at the Under graduate level.
7. Applicants to B.Com / B.Com (Accounting & Finance) should have studied Accountancy and Commerce in HSC.
8. Applicants to M.Com.(General) Should have studied B.Com., B.Com. (Accounting & Finance), or any UG Commerce courses.
9. Applicants to B.Com CS should have studied Commerce and Accountancy or Vocational Course with Secretarial Practice and Office Management as a subject in HSC.
10. Applicants to B.B.A should have studied Commerce, Accountancy or Vocational subjects or any Science Subjects in HSC.
11. **A separate application form must be submitted for each Course at a free of cost.**

Students with good behavior & a Conduct Certificate alone will be admitted irrespective of the total marks they have secured and provided they have passed in the first attempt. Student should always come with their Parents or Guardians for Admission.

HOW TO APPLY ?

Free Application Forms and Prospectus can be obtained from the College Office at Minjur .
Completed Application Forms for admission should be submitted in the College Office at Minjur.
During Registration and Processing fee for UG Rs.100/- and for PG Rs.200/- should be paid.

Incomplete Application Forms will not be entertained. An Interview Card will be issued and admission will be made only after personal interview and wherever necessary after approval by the University.

Any candidate who does not appear for the interview at the specified time and date will automatically forfeit admission. Every admission is subject to verification of the original mark certificates by the competent authorities if any mark certificate is found to be faulty or false, the admission is liable to be cancelled at any time during the course of study, and the defaulter will be liable for criminal action.

Foreign students will be admitted only if they possess a valid visa and approval from the competent authorities.

All original certificates except the Community Certificate submitted at the time of admission will be retained in the college Office and will not be returned under any circumstance until the student leaves the institution. **Students are, therefore advised to take sufficient Xerox copies of all certificates before submitting the originals to the College.**

DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED FOR ADMISSION

At the time of admission the following certificates and documents must be submitted in original along with Two sets of xerox copies.

1. Mark Sheets (HSC(+1, +2) / X Std. /Degree as applicable along with two Xerox copies and Community Certificates with the Original Certificates. Students seeking admission from Universities other than University of Madras, should produce an ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE from the University of Madras in Original.
2. Transfer Certificate.
3. Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied.
4. Community Certificate.
5. Medical Fitness Certificate. (wherever necessary)
6. Two Stamp Size Photographs and Four passport size photographs with name & address written on the back.
7. Group Photo with Parents.
8. Xerox copy of Family Smart Card.
9. Aadhar card of the student
10. Degree / Provisional Degree Certificate and UG marksheet (in the case of P.G. Courses)
11. Xerox copy of the front page of the bank passbook

All admissions are provisional. Admissions will be confirmed only after the genuineness of the certificates has been verified.

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

Admission to a course of study will be made only on payment of the fees prescribed fees. The fees are payable in two Semesters in an academic year.

A student who has enrolled and paid the fees for a Course is expected to complete the full course. If a student wishes to leave the College in the middle of the course, He/She will have to pay the entire fees, including special fees etc., for the whole course of 3 or 2 years , as the case may be.

Only Parents or Guardians who have admitted the students by signing the application for admission can represent them. No other Relatives/Family Elders/Friends will be allowed to represent the students.

The Caution Deposit will be refunded only at the end of the full course and will not be adjusted against any other payments. Fines and cost of damage to College property will be deducted from the Deposits, if the student is found to be involved directly or indirectly.

ROLE OF THE PARENTS / GUARDIANS

Parents must ensure that their wards attend classes punctually and regularly and take tests and examinations and maintaining good academic performance. Parents are welcome to meet the respective Heads of the Department or Principal at any time during working hours to enquire about their wards. They Should also ensure that the Students pay their Tuition and Examination Fees on time. They should also attend the Parents - Teacher meeting organised by the College periodically . They should sign the progress report of their wards and return it to the College. They may also collect the phone number of the HODs for appropriate communication.

MENTOR SYSTEM

Mentoring is a professional relationship in which an experienced person (mentor) assists another (Mentee) in developing specific skills and knowledge that enhance the Mentees professional and personal growth. It is a sustained relationship between a Teacher and Student. Through continuous involvement, the staff provide support, guidance and assistance to student who face Challenges or difficulties, helping them to overcome problems at an early stage. Selected faculty members of the College will guide students to developing their skills in all aspects.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO ALL APPLICANTS

1. Admissions are made on the basis of merit and the Rules and Regulations prescribed by the University of Madras and the Govt. of Tamilnadu.
2. Classes will be held for 5 days in a week – from 9.40 a.m. to 2.50 p.m. with 30 minutes break for lunch from 12.30 to 1.00 p.m. Saturdays will be conducted as and when necessary. **Being a Jain Minority Institution, National and Jain religious holidays will be observed . However Staff , Students belonging to other religions will be permitted to take religious leave on their important religious occasions.**

The Management reserves the right to make further changes in timing.

3. **The medium of instruction is English for all the Courses in the College.**
4. **ONLY VEGETARIAN FOOD IS ALLOWED INSIDE THE COLLEGE CAMPUS and any violation is punishable.**
5. **RAGGING and EVE TEASING- WARNING TO ALL THE STUDENTS:**

As per the Extract of the Tamil Nadu Govt. Gazette - extra ordinary dated 26.07.1999 (Act.No.7 of 1997 Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act) Ragging is totally prohibited both inside and outside the College campus. Similarly Eve teasing will also be dealt with severely resulting in the expulsion of the offender and Criminal action under (Tamilnadu Prohibition of Eve Teasing Act, 1998). The Anti- Ragging Squad has been constituted to monitor student activities involving in ragging and eve teasing. Immediate action such as lodging a complaint with the Police (or) issuing a Transfer Certificate will be taken if any incident of ragging is reported.

6. Tobacco in any form and Liquor are strictly prohibited inside the campus and anybody found violating this Rule will be expelled from the College.
7. Students should wear decent & dignified formal attire when attending the College
8. The College is above politics and no cliques or parties will be allowed to function with in the College. Any student who organizes or attempts to organize or joins a strike, he/she will be immediately suspended from the College. Students involved in such activities may be expelled.
9. Students are prohibited from organizing any meetings in the College or Collecting funds for any purpose without the permission of the Principal.
10. Students, are advised to open a Savings Bank Account in any one of the Nationalised / Scheduled Banks, so that they can receive Scholarship / Refund of Caution Deposit / Refund of Book Bank Caution Deposit.

11. **ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE**

Every students must attend the College regularly and punctually on all working days. A minimum of 75% attendance is required to be eligible to appear for the University Examination/ Railway & Travel concession / Book Bank and Scholarship.

12. **LAB REGULATIONS, TESTS & EXAMINATIONS**

All the students are expected to complete Lab experiments (wherever applicable). Fines will be levied for damage caused to lab equipments. A Minimum of 75% of attendance in Practical Classes is required to appear for University Practical Examinations.

N.S.S. - N.C.C.- R.R.C.- Y.R.C.-C.C.C.- I.I.C- E.D.C -V.Y.F

The College has three NSS with a total strength of 300 student volunteers. The three NSS Units of the College help students develop their talents while rendering service to humanity. Students who are members of NSS are given ample opportunities to participate in Community works. KARUNA CLUB

The Karuna Club is instituted to motivate the students to practice non-violence, Ahimsa and Vegetarianism and to inculcate the human values in the minds of the young.

ENVIRO CLUB

A Special Club meant to inculcate awareness on Global Warming, climate change, ecological disorder etc., is also functioning. Students can learn and contribute their efforts to keep the Planet Earth, a proper place for the civilization to survive.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION & SPORTS

Physical Education facilities for a variety of games and sports activities are offered. Both men and women Students are encouraged to participate in all sports activities organized at the inter-collegiate, Divisional, University and Inter University level. Winners at the university level get ample employment opportunities in Railways, Banks and Public Sector Undertakings.

LIBRARY

Books related to various disciplines as well as those of general interest are available for reference and the issue in the College Library. Each student will be issued with two Library Cards for borrowing books from the Library which can be retained for a week. Books should be returned on or before the due date, failing which a fine of two rupees per day will be charged. If a student damages or loses a book, he/she will have to replace the book or pay twice of the cost the book.

BOOK BANK

Important text books are being provided to the needy and deserving students for their study and are to be returned on a Refundable deposit of Rs.300/- for Arts and Rs. 500/- for UG Science and PG Students. This Facility is available for 300 Students from I Year to III Year, and altogether 900 students.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CELL

The EDC of SCPJC is registered under TN-EDI undertakes several activities for student development wherein the students gain corporate exposure while studying and develops a spirit of entrepreneurship. This enhance student capabilities as well as their alignment with Industry. EDC conducts various certification courses under MSME Scheme. The Entrepreneurship development cell bridges the gap between ideas to the market product.

CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CELL

The Placement and Career Guidance Cell actively conducts various programmes and training sessions, and has signed MoUs to enhance students' career opportunities. Below is a summary of the initiatives undertaken:

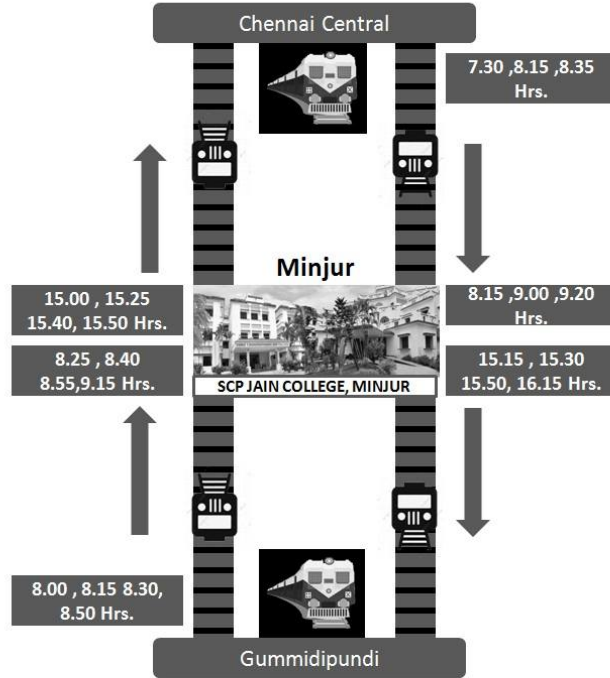
*** University Exam Fees to be paid along with College Fees.**
